Recognize shape:; circle, square, Triangle, rectangle, star, heart	Sort by color and shape
Recognize numbers 1-20 (minimum)	Match number of objects to number (1-20)
Sort by sets of two, three	Opposites: big/little, wide/narrow
Count days on calendar (daily)	long/short, full/empty, inside/outside

Recognize numbers up to 30 (minimum)
Write numbers up to 20 (minimum)
Match number of objects to number up to 30 (minimum)

Colors: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple, brown,
black, white, grey, pink, and shades of these colors
Sequencing 3-5 items
Sorting by color, size, and shape
star, heart
